A walk to commemorate and honour the 10,000 children who were brought to the UK on the *Kindertransport*

Sunday, 2 December 2018

Walk from The Liberal Jewish Synagogue, 28 St John's Wood Road, London NW8 7HA to Liverpool Street Station - approximately 5 miles



Programme details and how to register: please read carefully

This is a self-guided walk. Participants must register and will be given a choice of routes to follow from The LIS to Liverpool Street Station. You are advised to walk in small groups of 3-4 people.

11.30 am	Walkers depart from the LJS in small groups from this time until 12.00 pm.
1.00 pm	Refreshments will be served at the LJS for all those going by coach.
2.30 pm	Coach departs from the LJS to Liverpool Street Station.
3.30 pm	Short ceremony to mark the 80 th Anniversary of the first arrival of the <i>Kindertransport</i> at Liverpool Street Station and lighting of the candle for the first night of <i>Chanukkah</i> , organised by World Jewish Relief . Situated next to Frank Meisler's <i>Kindertransport</i> memorial statue.

Arrive at the LJS with warm clothes and walking shoes. Refreshments will be served.

Please note that there may not be enough seats for walkers to be seated at Liverpool Street station for the ceremony. It may be possible to stand nearby, but it is the walk that is important.
